§ 1 Fees

- (1) The ticket price for a visit to the museum is €5.00 per person for adults and €3.00 per person for trainees, pupils, students, people with disabilities and recipients of social welfare.
- (2) The use of multimedia companions for your own mobile devices or on a rental device is included in the ticket price.
- (3) Public guided tours of the exhibition and the city of Weimar cost €7.00 per person for individual visitors and €3.00 per person for trainees, school pupils, students, people with disabilities and recipients of social assistance. The price also includes admission to the museum.
- (4) Guided tours of the city, one-day, multi-day and online events for groups of adults with up to 15 people cost 15 people cost € 80.00 per event and with more than 15 people up to 30 people cost € 120.00 per event.
- (5) Tours, one-day, multi-day and online events for groups of trainees, school pupils, students, people with disabilities and recipients of social assistance with up to 15 people cost €40.00 per event and with more than 15 people up to 30 people cost €60.00 per event.
- (6) Guided tours of the exhibition for groups with up to 15 people cost €80.00 per tour for adults and €40.00 per tour for school pupils, students, people with disabilities and recipients of social assistance.
- (7) In special cases, the fees for admission to the museum and guided tours for individual visitors can be reduced or waived.
- (8) If an online event is booked as preparation for or follow-up to a face-to-face event, the fee for the face-to-face event also covers the digital event. The fee for online events shall be paid by bank transfer no later than 7 days before the event.
- (9) Requests must be sent in writing to the museum's visitor information centre, stating the exact address of the person responsible, and will be confirmed in writing.
- (10) Visits to the museum are free of charge for former victims of Nazi persecution and their direct relatives, as well as for members of the International Council of Museums (ICOM) and the German Museums Association (OMB). Information on offers can be found at www.museum-zwangsarbeit.de.


§ 2 Cancellation / Delay

- (1) If the group or individual that has booked an event is unable to attend the event, immediate written cancellation is requested. If the cancellation is made 7 days to 24 hours before the scheduled date and time, a cancellation fee in the amount of 50% of the agreed fee will be charged. If the cancellation is made less than 24 hours before the scheduled date and time or not at all, a cancellation fee in the amount of 100% of the agreed fee will be charged.
- (2) If the group is delayed by more than 30 minutes, there is no entitlement to the agreed service. The fee is due irrespective of the provision of the service.

§ 3 Final provision

The schedule of fees applies from 1 July 2025.
