

# SCHEDULE OF FEES



## Schedule of fees for visits to the *Museum of Forced Labor under National Socialism*

### § 1 Fees

- (1) Admission to the museum costs 5 Euro per person for adults / 3 Euro per person for vocational trainees, school students, university students, disabled persons, and social benefit recipients, etc.
- (2) The use of a multimedia guide on the visitor's own mobile device or on a rental device is included in the admission fee.
- (3) Public guided tours of the exhibition and the city of Weimar for individual visitors cost 7 Euro per person for adults / 3 Euro per person for vocational trainees, school students, university students, disabled persons, and social benefit recipients, etc. The price includes admission to the museum.
- (4) Guided tours of the city, workshops, and one-day, multi-day, and online events for groups of adults with up to 15 persons cost 80 Euro per event / with 16 to 30 persons 120 Euro per event.
- (5) Guided tours of the city, workshops, and one-day, multi-day, and online events for groups of vocational trainees, school students, university students, disabled persons, or social benefit recipients, etc. with up to 15 persons cost 40 Euro per event / with 16 to 30 persons 60 Euro per event.
- (6) Guided tours of the exhibition for groups of maximum 15 persons cost 80 Euro per tour for adults / 40 Euro per tour for vocational trainees, school students, university students, disabled persons, or social benefit recipients, etc.
- (7) In special cases, the fees for admission to the museum and guided tours for individual visitors can be reduced or waived.

- (8) If an online event is booked in preparation for or follow-up on an in-person event, the fee for the in-person event also covers the cost of the digital event. Payment of the fee for online events shall be made by bank transfer upon receipt of the invoice, at the latest 7 days prior to the event.
- (9) Booking enquiries should include the exact address of the responsible party and be addressed in writing to the museum's visitor information office. Enquirers will receive written confirmation of receipt of the enquiry.
- (10) Former victims of Nazi persecution and their immediate family members are exempt from admission fees, as are members of the International Council of Museums (ICOM) and the German Museum Association (DMB). ### § 2 Cancellation / Late Arrival

- (1) Groups that are unable to attend a booked event are requested to send immediate written cancellation. If the cancellation is submitted 7 days to 24 hours prior to the scheduled date, a cancellation fee in the amount of 50% of the agreed fee will be charged. If the cancellation is submitted less than 24 hours prior to the scheduled date or not at all, a cancellation fee in the amount of 100% of the agreed fee will be charged.
- (2) If a group or an individual is more than 30 minutes late to their pre-booked event, they are no longer entitled to the agreed service. The fee is due regardless of the performance of the service.

### § 3 Final provision

This schedule of fees takes effect on 1 July 2026.
